The meeting of the Battlefield Fire Protection District Board of Directors was called to order by Chairman Trevor Crist at 5:00 pm. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was established. Board Members Present: Chairman Trevor Crist, Vice-Chair Danny Perches, Treasurer Mark Pon, and Member Jen Albers.

Mr. Perches moved to approve the agenda, noting an additional item will be added to the Financial Business section for Audit Review. 2nd by Mr. Pon. Motion carried.




